

Dear wearer,

Firstly, we'd like to take this opportunity to thank you and your team for all the incredible work you are doing during these times. Please find enclosed your requested masks made by our fabulous group of sewers at Cornwall Cloth Masks. Our masks have all been made by volunteers and are used at the wearers own risk. Cornwall cloth masks are intended for community workers and not those directly caring for anyone who has or potentially has Covid-19.

A few notes on the masks:

- Safety Notice - Face Mask Disclaimer: these Face masks have been made as an urgent response following an appeal to provide PPE during the Covid-19 Pandemic. The optional metal nose strip has been supplied to help with the fitting of the mask if required. The mask and nose piece have not undergone the usual rigorous safety tests required of PPE and if worn the wearer does so at their own risk and the makers bear no liability.
- The masks have been washed, ironed and handled with care before they were sent with you, but it is probably wise to treat them with caution and wash them again (over 70 degrees) before you start using them.
- The masks are reusable and should be washed at the end of each day.
- We recommend the masks are replaced various times a day, we suggest every 2-3 hours, or when you see fit.
- The nose bridges can be slotted in and removed easily. Please remove them before washing. If they wear out, then let us know and we will send you a new batch. Peel off the thin blue plastic cover before use. **WARNING: Nose bridge CHOKING HAZARD keep away from small children.** The nose bridges are made by friends, who like us all, are helping for free. They will not have been through a quality assurance and may be sharp around the edges. Please be aware of the hazards and take your own steps to keep you and others safe.

The makers would really like to receive feedback in order to improve the design, so if you have a suggestion and a moment to write it up then do send us 'how they wear'!
